

What to bring:



Bible
Pillow
Linens
Sleeping Bag
Toiletries (towels and wash clothes, soap, shampoo, etc.)
Personal Hygiene Items
Gloves (for working)
Jeans-for working outside; you might be working in an area with tall grass, etc.
T-shirts or other shirts you won't mind getting dirty-Remember: No Spaghetti Strap, halter tops, or tank tops less than 2 inches at the shoulder.
Shorts must be finger tip length.
Closed-toe shoes suitable for working
Casual clothes for worship
Money for snacks or drinks during downtime (3 meals a day are covered by the camp fee you already paid)

What NOT to bring:

Drugs
Alcohol
Tobacco
Fireworks
Weapons or anything that could be used as a weapon
Water guns
Water balloons
